TENEMENTS GRANTED AND APPOINTMENT OF HYDROGEOLOGICAL CONSULTANT

Highlights

- Key tenements have been granted for the Mackay Sulphate of Potash Project
- Notice of Works Program has been submitted to the native title service provider
- Appointment of a highly experienced Hydrogeological Consultant

Agrimin Limited (ASX: AMN) ("Agrimin" or "the Company") is pleased to announce that four of the five Western Australian tenement applications for the Mackay Project have been granted by the Department of Mines and Petroleum through an expedited process. This follows the signing of the Land Access Agreement between Agrimin and Tjamu Tjamu (Aboriginal Corporation) RNTBC in December 2014.

Tenements E80/4887, E80/4889, E80/4890 and E80/4893 have been granted. The fifth Western Australian tenement E80/4888 is expected to be granted in the coming months (**Figure 1**). Agrimin has now submitted a Notice of Works Program to the native title service provider and is progressing through the standard approvals process to allow for on-ground exploration activities.


